2019 MOAA Scholarships

The Fort Knox Area Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America (MOAA) is planning to offer six (6) \$1,500 scholarships and one (1) \$2,500 scholarship in 2019 for eligible graduating seniors who plan to continue their education. These scholarships are to be used for tuition, books, or fees for the first year while attending an accredited college, university, vocational, or technical school. If you are interested in applying for these scholarships, they will be available from the high school counselor early in January 2019. Please complete the application and return it to the above address with a postmark on or before **March 29, 2019**.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- be (1) a family member (dependent) of an active duty, Guard or Reserve military service member or (2) a family member of a 20-year or medically retired or deceased active duty, Guard or Reserve service member or (3) the grandson/granddaughter of a 20 year or medically retired (living or deceased), active duty, Guard or Reserve service member. In all three cases, the rank or branch of service of the service member is not a factor.
- be a graduating senior attending a high school or home school program in the Fort Knox area (Ft Knox, Hardin County, Meade County, LaRue County, Elizabethtown Independent, FAITH Home School, and North Hardin Christian School).
- have applied to attend an accredited college, university, vocational, or technical school.
- may not be a recipient of a full four-year scholarship or have accepted an appointment to a military academy. In the event that this occurs, the scholarship will be withdrawn and awarded to an alternate.
- have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA or be in the upper half of your graduating class
- the application packet must contain an official copy of the ACT/SAT score as well as an official copy of the transcript with your cumulative GPA and class rank.
- include a copy of the front and back of your dependent or Sponsor's Military ID card.

Scholarship recipient must provide the Fort Knox Area Chapter with proof of enrollment in an educational institution before the check will be issued to the college, vocational, or technical school. The scholarship must be claimed by July 12, 2019 or the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate. If you do not plan to enroll in the fall semester or quarter, you must notify the Scholarship Chair.

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Letters of recommendation are not required and will not be considered. You will be notified at your school Awards Night if you are a scholarship winner.
