It is open to families with at least one child in a Hardin County Schools District.

Who Can Sign Up:

Head of Household – Must show picture ID

Children **MUST** reside with person making application

Application Information:

Please provide proof of Financial Need

- Food stamp number **OR**
- Verifying written statement by head of household on application

If applying for assistance for children:

- Must be **0 – 18 years of age** (qualifying special needs students still enrolled in high school up to age 21)
- **16 – 18 year olds must be enrolled in high school**
