Policy on Guidelines for Students Attending Overnight School Sponsor Events/Trips

The criteria listed below will be used to guide teachers when making recommendations/decisions on a student's participation on a school sponsored overnight trip and/or event.

1. Suspension from school.
2. Violation of the current Hardin County Code of Conduct and/or G. C. Burkhead's "Respect Policy."
3. Hitting or striking fellow students or school personnel.
4. Being called to the principal or assistant principal's office for disciplinary action during the school year for any of the following:
 - Failure of student to follow directives of school personnel
 - Destruction of school property
 - Being disrespectful towards teachers
 - Use of profane or indecent language
 - Transportation problems involving Hardin County School Buses during the regular school day

A final discussion concerning the student's attendance will be held between the teacher(s) and principal/assistant principal.

When the decision is made, a conference will be held involving the parent, the student's teacher, and principal/assistant principal.

Disruptive behavior by the student on the overnight school sponsored event/trip will result in the students being sent home. The parent(s) will be responsible for all arrangements to transport their child home.
