Celebrations

- Mrs. Burks shared that a student who struggles with accepting accountability showed responsibility for his actions today.
- Mrs. Erizer shared that a student who was struggling with acting out due to peer influences has made a positive turn in his behavior.
- Mrs. Hoopingarner shared that one of her KSI behavior students is showing tremendous growth.

Monthly Data (ABE)

- Many referrals for severe disruption and physical aggression.
- 70%-80% in the classroom
- Restroom and lunch are increasing in referrals
- Increase in the number of referrals after lunch
- Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays are higher this month
- Transitions and math are a concern

Tier 2 & 3 Updates (Interventions/Progress/Fidelity)

- Mrs. Hoopingarner shared...
 - 21 students are currently receiving formal KSI in the area of behavior
 - 3 are on the watchlist
 - 1 student is in folder check with the school psych
 - Some of the students are doing well on their chart, but have explosive setbacks

Suggestions to Address Behavioral Concerns

- Mrs. Brus will bring back a report of each grade level for the team to analyze in order to discuss possible suggestions for support.

- Mrs. Brus will focus on the respectful tickets and start a weekly drawing to help build a respectful school community.
- Like we plan for HOT questions, we need to plan for what specific respectful behaviors we are going to look for.

Staff Questions or Concerns

2. What does respect look like for us to be able to focus on this with our kids? Grade level teams need to work together on what this will look like for them based on the behaviors being exhibited by their students.
