The North Park Elementary School staff believes open lines of communication between parents/guardians and staff provides a solid foundation on which to build a strong partnership. The administration, staff, and parents/guardians believe that the improved academic achievement of each student is the responsibility shared by the entire school community to prepare students for a lifelong love of learning.

We believe in the following definition of parent/guardian involvement and will carry out programs, activities, and procedures in accordance with this definition:


Parent/Guardian involvement means the participation of parents/guardians in regular, two-way meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring that:

- 1. Parents/Guardians play an integral part in their child's learning;**
- 2. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school; and**
- 3. Parents/Guardians are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child.**


North Park Elementary School staff and parents/guardians will take the following measures to involve parents/guardians in creating a successful educational experience for all children:

- **Hold an annual meeting to inform families of the schools participation in Title 1 and to explain the Title I program. The school will convene the meeting at a convenient time to parents/guardians, and will offer a flexible number of additional parent/guardian involvement meetings, such as in the morning or evening, so that as many parents/guardians as possible are able to attend. The school will invite to this meeting all parents/guardians of all children.**
- **Involve parents/guardians in the joint development of any school-wide program plan, in an organized, ongoing, and timely way.**
- **Provide parents/guardians with access to the Parent & Family Engagement Policy, the School Compact, an explanation of the school curriculum, assessments, Core Content and proficiency levels students are expected to meet.**
- **Shall provide materials and training to help parents/guardians work with their children to improve individual achievement, such as literacy training and using technology, as appropriate, to foster parent/guardian involvement;**
- **Opportunities for parent/guardians to volunteer and be involved in school activities;**
- **Involve parents/guardians in the planning, review and improvement of the policy at least annually by inviting them to take part in developing the School Improvement Plan (SIP).**
